A Look at a Sunsational Summer Camp "Day" at St. Linus...

9:00am ~ 9:30am: Free Play: This time would consist of play time in the enclosed outdoors courtyard or inside gym, weather permitting. During this time different stations will be set up to correlate with each week's theme. Ordinary play time will now be an exciting time to imagine and explore.

9:30am ~ 10:00am: The Daily "Activity": This time of day we will delve into the theme for the week. Every Wednesday during this time will be a special themed art project. On Tuesdays and Thursdays we will make learning fun ~ whether we go back in prehistoric time to learn about the dinosaurs, learn how to cool down a warm summer day, set up camp, or wiggle our way into the wonderful world of worms, it will be a time to remember!

10:00am ~ 10:30am: Sport's Development: We will learn and play a variety of fun, skill-developing games. Here at sensational summer camp we put a "team" effort into our games and really learn how to play together while developing coordination, stability, and movement skills.

10:30am ~ 11:00am: Snack/Cool Down: We will take a break and eat a snack provided by camp. Some examples of snack would be: granola bars, pretzels, freeze pops, crackers, and fruit snacks. Water will be available at all times during the day. ***Your child is encouraged to bring a water bottle to camp every day, labeled with his/her name.***

11:00am ~ 11:30am: Nature Walk: During this time we will grab our magnifying glass and binoculars as we explore different areas around the school. We never know what we will find out there, but we know it will be exciting to see the different birds, insects, and animals that surround us!

11:30am ~ 12:00pm: Free Play: We will revisit the courtyard to end our day exploring the outdoor planned activities!

Things to Remember...

- Please send your child to camp with a water bottle labeled with his/her name.
- Please dress your child in weather appropriate clothes.
- Gym shoes work best for camp, since we will be exploring outdoors.
- Please apply sunscreen to your child prior to sending them to camp.
- If you would like us to reapply sunscreen to your child during the day, please fill out the attached sunscreen permission slip and bring a bottle of sunscreen with your child's name on it. Sunscreen will be reapplied during snack time.
